STATEMENT OF REASONS

Many residents live in shared accommodation, flats or houses where storage space is at a premium and it can be difficult to find secure cycle storage. This can be a major barrier to those wishing to travel by bike. Storage can be especially challenging if you use an adapted cycle. People can also face difficulties manoeuvring their cycles from inside their home onto the street outside.

As part of our ongoing work to support active and sustainable travel, Brighton & Hove City Council will be rolling out a programme of installing on-road cycle hangars for residents to park their bikes securely near their homes.

We have received many requests and seen a need for these hangars in these proposed areas. The cycle hangars are the size of approximately one parking space, and they can store up to six standard sized bicycles.
