**Admissions arrangements for 2021/22**

Thank you once again to those of you who provided feedback during the recent admissions consultation. Your thoughts are much appreciated and have been considered throughout the consultation process.

The governing body has agreed on the Admissions Arrangements for 2021/22, a copy of which is attached to this email.

The following key changes have been adopted from the proposed changes when the school is over subscribed:

1. Reduction from 13 to 5 oversubscription criteria
2. Removal of Hove Group Ministry churches as this no longer exists
3. Small changes to the "supplementary information form" to make it clearer

The 50:50 split between Foundation and Community places has been retained. Please note that the 50:50 allocation will be applied after places under Criteria 1 and 2 have been allocated.

Criteria 1. A 'looked after child' or a child who was previously 'looked after', but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangements order or special guardianship order)

Criteria 2. Children who have a sibling at the school at the time of admission.

As an example, if the school PAN (Published Admissions Number) is 90 for that year, and 10 places are allocated under Criteria 1 and 2, the remaining 80 places would be split between foundation (50%) and community (50%) places, equalling 40 places in each category. In the event fewer applications are received for either category, unfilled places would become additional places in the other category.
